Services

Congregate Meals:

Congregate meals are meals served at our Senior Dining Centers, located throughout the county. Seniors are encouraged to come and have meals while enjoying the company of friends.

Home Delivered Meals:

Meals are delivered by volunteer drivers, weekdays at approximately noon. Cold sack lunches and frozen meals are available to eligible seniors for evening and weekend dining.

Respite Care:

Respite Care Workers provide relief and time away for primary caregivers.

Homemaking Services:

Homemakers will assist clients with light housekeeping, meal preparation, laundry services and other related activities.



Personal Care:

Personal Care Workers assist clients with activities of daily living. This may include bathing, dressing, and grooming.

Case Coordination and Support:

Case Workers assist in evaluating the needs of clients and provide information on services available.

Caregiver Training:

This service is to provide support to family members and friends who are struggling to care for their loved ones that are ill or have disabilities.

Friendly Driver:

The Friendly Driver Program is a volunteer based program that provides low cost transportation to medical appointments for elderly community members.

Service Costs:

Meals, Case Coordination,

all seniors on a suggested contribution
basis. No one will be denied services
due to the lack of ability to pay.

Who Can Receive Services?

In-Home Services:

 Seniors who are 60 or over who need assistance with Respite Care, Personal Care, or Homemaking Services due to limited mobility or ability.

Home Delivered Meals:

- Anyone 60 years or over who is homebound with no means to get or prepare meals for themselves.
- A spouse of an eligible homebound senior who needs assistance with meals to help provide time to care for his or her spouse.

Congregate Meals:

- A Senior (or spouse when accompanied by a senior) who is 60 or over.
- A handicapped person residing in a high-rise where meals are being served to seniors.
